After a grueling 3 days of knock out rounds, our two Siem Reap FC teams were placed 1st and 2nd from 118 teams from across Siem Reap Province. Siem Reap FC is made up mainly of our COACHES of YES FOOTBALL ACADEMY. So both teams plus our YES Football Academy team are in the top 12 Teams from Siem Reap to play in Phnom Penh in the Tiger Street National Finals next month, 16 - 17th March.

For the first time our young Y.E.S Football Academy boys have made it to the TOP 64 Teams out of more than 500 teams competing from around the country playing off in the National Finals. This is proof that Feeding Dreams Football Program WORKS, giving underprivileged youth purpose and goals, self-worth and pride.

On Tuesday the 5th of February our incredible charity riders from around the world cycled into our school, completing 650km's of biking across the Kingdom of Wonder in support of our poor children and their families.

Hundreds of our kids, all staff, our rider's supporters and members of the local community lined the street awaiting their arrival – all SO PROUD of their colossal achievement. The Finish Line Celebration saw our children singing 'Celebrate Good Times Come On!' to the riders, streamers were flying and the entire school was buzzing with excitement.

Our rider Rose Wilson stated: 'For me it was extremely emotional, and I couldn't hold back the tears...Riding into Feeding Dreams was the pinnacle of it all, that's what it was all about'.

Our exhausted riders presented bicycles and football kits to the children that they had ridden for and after hundreds of hugs, hi-fives and broad brim smiles the riders left the school with full hearts, onto their hotel for a memorable night of celebration.

To top it all off, the next day our riders spent an afternoon at Feeding Dreams, mentoring in the class rooms and versing the kids in the annual riders Vs. children soccer match. In theme with last year, despite some competitive riders (Ollie), the kids smashed the riders winning 5 to 2. The experience was phenomenal, and the sense of achievement each rider felt when after raising the money, completing the challenge, and riding through our gates was incomparable to anything they had ever done before.

78 lives changed at our 3rd Dreams Training Center graduation

In only 3 years, our Dreams Vocational Training Center has grown to achieve more than we could ever have possibly hoped for.

In December our team proudly watched as 78 of our youth stood before us to accept their internationally recognized ASEAN certificates in Hospitality.

We were proud to know that all 78 of these adolescents received full-time employment in reputable hotels within the growing tourism sector in Siem Reap.

Many of the youth's parents and siblings attended the event, some had travelled over 5 hours from the poverty-stricken borders to see their children graduate. This made our hearts burst.

Our facility has now successfully taken 146 Cambodian youth out of exploitative labour, and into accredited fair paying jobs in luxury hotels. Feeding Dreams would like to take this opportunity to congratulate our Dreams Training Center General Manager Mr. Makara Seng and each of our skilled trainers who have worked around the clock, with compassion and dedication, to ensure every one of their students gain the confidence and skills required to be successful.

Our team have spent the last few months travelling across Cambodia on their motorbikes visiting the homes of our 2019 applicants. At the start of this month we have welcomed 60 brand new students into our program and look forward to sharing their journeys and transformations with you.
