## **Feeding Dreams AU**

We are excited to report that Feeding Dreams Cambodia (AU) has been officially accepted as a registered charity by the Australian Charities and Not for Profits Commission, <a href="www.acnc.gov.au">www.acnc.gov.au</a>. This is run by the Australian Government who strictly control all registered charities to ensure they meet a comprehensive compliance program. Feeding Dreams Cambodia (AU) was established as a way for Australian supporters to continue to support Feeding Dreams Cambodia and the children and families they sponsor.

Feeding Dreams Cambodia (AU) is now progressing in its application to acquire Gift Deductibility Recipient status, which will allow all donations over \$2 to be claimed as a legitimate tax deduction by the donor. We will keep you up to date on the progress of this application.
